COLOMBIA

20 to 30 January '18

A special trip during which travellers will visit the Open Doors Children's Centre, which is a safe house for children whose families face death threats, or have been killed, due to their faith in Christ. Travellers will be at the Centre to welcome children back after they've been home for the holidays. They are usually in particular need of encouragement as they miss home. We invite travellers to join us in strengthening their faith and motivating them for the new school year.

COLOMBIA

21 to 30 April '18

The trip will focus on post-conflict reconciliation. Travellers will visit a region in Colombia where the Church is near a zone with demobilized people from the FARC, the largest guerrilla group in the country.

COLOMBIA

12 to 19 May '18

Travellers will arrive in Bogota and then fly to the coast of Colombia. They will visit teenagers from the Arauco tribe, the children of persecuted pastors and leaders. They live at a new Open Doors safe house in the region, as all Christians from this tribe face particularly severe persecution.

EAST AFRICA

September '18

Travellers will be able to encourage persecuted believers and visit Open Doors projects. The purpose of the trip is to introduce travellers to the local persecuted Church, with the expectation that visitors would share messages of encouragement and pray with those suffering for Christ. Travellers will also be shown some of the ways in which Open Doors assists and encourages the local persecuted Church. The itinerary will include meeting with several families or groups of believers.

COLOMBIA

16 to 26 June '18

During the school holidays, the children at the Open Doors Children's Centre can go home, but some of them can't afford it, and for others it is simply too dangerous. The purpose of the trip is to host activities for the children, staying at the Centre, making it easier for them while they are missing home, along with encouraging them in their faith.

COLOMBIA

30 November to 9 December '18

Travellers will participate in a camp for the children from the Open Doors Children's Centre and attend the Centre's graduation ceremony and celebration. Travellers will also be able to meet some of the children's parents to encourage them. Many of the parents travel far distances from areas where the pressure from illegal groups is very heavy on them.

LEBANON

The trip is focussed on the youth (18 to 30). Travellers will meet refugees from Syria and provide encouragement to children and youth at children's camps in Lebanon. Since the planned programmes and activities target refugee children, travellers will be asked to raise the funds to cover both their trip and the cost of the camps. The threeday camps include a Bible study or devotional message, songs, puppetry, games and crafts, lunch, and a morning and afternoon snack. Costs will include the transportation of the children to the venue; insurance; rent for the location where the programme will be held.

The dynamics of Christian persecution in this part of the world is complex, and one of the main purposes of the trip will be to give greater insight into these complexities. The programme will include meetings with the local body of Christ, visiting Open Doors projects, prayer, presence ministry and some (biblical) sightseeing.

Iberia is a country in the Middle East where hundreds of Christians are imprisoned. The trip will focus on prayer, as this is a very high security country. Please contact us for more information about the trip.

March '18

Travellers will visit an area where many Christian brothers and sisters face severe restrictions for their faith, and the focus of the trip will be prayer. The destination country has recently experienced heavy flooding - the worst disaster in this area since World War II. One night will be spent in a village, where the group will visit local homes, play volleyball against the local team, practice local cooking, and enjoy fellowship with host families
