



The Open Doors World Watch List (WWL) is released every January and ranks the Top 50 countries where Christians face the worst forms of persecution. Persecution is defined as any hostility experienced because of one's identification with Christ. The WWL takes into account all spheres of life and incidents of violence. The methods for arriving at country scores and their transnational comparison have been independently audited by the International Institute for Religious Freedom and their proper application checked on some sample countries. Additional statements and interpretations by Open Doors, based on or associated with the publication of the WWL, remain outside the scope of this audit.

On the 2018 World Watch List (WWL), persecution is driven mainly by the Islamist revolutionary movement, and religious and ideological nationalism. Christians in East, West and North Africa face increased persecution with the global rise and spread of the Islamist movement. In Asia there has been an increase in Islamic militancy as well as religious and ideological nationalism.
