North Korea continues to hold the top spot on the World Watch List, as it's the most stiflingly authoritarian regime in the world. But as a trend, state authoritarianism is increasing in many parts of the world – as seen in China (#27). In a growing number of countries, nationalism is intensifying into an ultranationalism, as minority groups such as Christians are seen as a threat to those in power. And radical Islam rounds out this year's trends as Islamic militants spread into Sub-
