About India

In India, Christians face horrific levels of violence from extremists, with thousands of attacks taking place every year to which the government frequently turns a blind eye. Some extremist groups are working towards Hindutva, a process to make Indian rule exclusively Hindu. Officially, India has religious freedom. But several states have implemented anticonversion laws which makes it illegal to convert to Christianity.
