

About Maldives

A few thousand Christians live in the Maldives, but they're almost all expatriates and monitored closely. Sharing the Gospel with Muslims is illegal and can result in deportation. While, if Maldivian Christians are discovered, they'll lose their citizenship. Christians can't participate in any religious activities in public and simply owning a Bible can lead to imprisonment.



Many Maldivians seek solace in smoking or drugs due to restrictions on freedom. Pray that they'll turn to Jesus to experience true freedom.
