

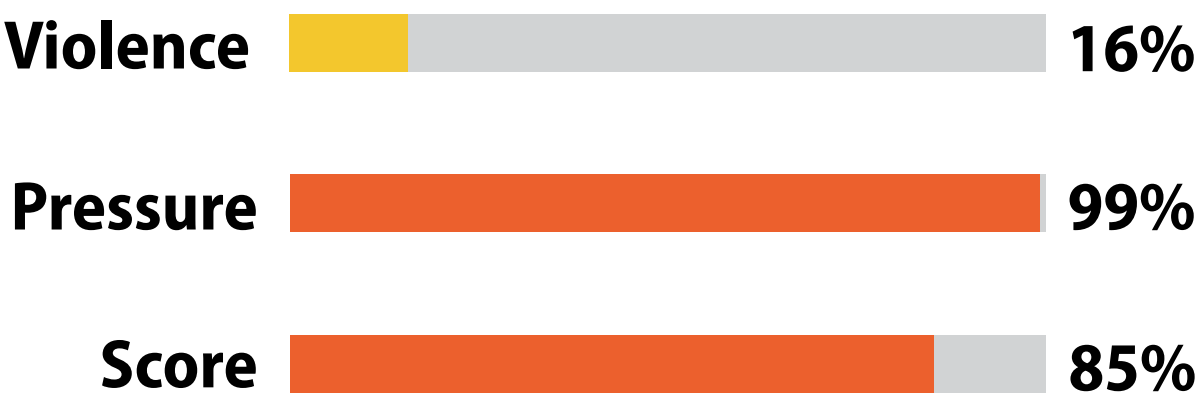

About Yemen

The ongoing civil war in Yemen has created one of the worst humanitarian crises in recent memory, making things harder for Christians. Converts must keep their faith completely secret as it's seen as a huge source of shame by families in this strongly Islamic nation. These converts run the risk of honour-killing or physical violence if their faith is discovered.



The instability in Yemen has created a refugee, food and healthcare crisis. Ask God to help provide food, clean water and safety to the Yemeni people.
