
Join us in praying for the Church by using this prayer map to pray for the various regions where Christians face increasing hostilities, isolation and persecution.

MIDDLE EAST

The Middle East is the birthplace of the Christian Church. Yet, in some areas today, the Church has almost been eliminated under Islamic oppression. Pray that God will rebuild His Church in places where the Church is declining and that throughout the region Christians will be salt and light amid the darkness.



ARABIAN PENINSULA

Pray for believers in this Muslim-dominated region, that God will equip them to stand strong in their faith. Pray that He'll give them wisdom as they interact with Muslims and that these Muslims will be drawn to Christ.



ASIA

Christians in Asia face much hostility from Muslim, Buddhist and Hindu extremists, as well as severe restrictions because of their faith. Pray that even under such hostility the Church in the region will flourish and become a powerhouse for the Kingdom of God.



LATIN AMERICA

The continued breakdown of state structures and distrust in the authorities has caused great social unrest. This increases the vulnerability of the Church in the region as organised crime groups and militias continue their reign of terror with impunity. Pray for peace and protection for the Church here, and that God will fill their hearts with hope.



AFRICA

The spread of violent Islamic militancy into politically weak states across sub-Saharan Africa places Christians in very difficult circumstances. Here, Islamic militants exploit ethnic, tribal and socioeconomic groups to create conditions that bring them recruits and increase their influence. Pray that God will equip the Church to face these challenges so that the hearts and minds of Africans will be won for the Kingdom.
