About Libya

Many believers risk their lives to follow Jesus, as all Libyans are considered Muslim and are forbidden from going to church. Converts to Christianity need to hide their faith. If discovered, they face abuse and violence for their decision. Libya is also home to many migrant workers who are face attacks, sexual assault, incarceration and human trafficking – which can be even worse if they're Christians.



Pray for new Christians, especially those converted from Islam as they're isolated from other believers – that they'll be strengthened and encouraged through the Holy Spirit.
