About Pakistan

Pakistan is a strongly Islamic society. Radical Islamic groups are increasingly influential and courted by political parties, the army and government. Christians are targets of violent attacks by extremists and treated as 'unclean' by society in general. They're also abused under Pakistan's infamous blasphemy laws, so are afraid to express their faith freely in case it's misinterpreted as blasphemy.



Pray for Christians accused under blasphemy laws, that they'll not face violence or mob "justice" and that they'll stand strong in the midst of great risk.
