MARCH

WOMEN OF FAITH

Sunday, 1 March

Pray for women of faith standing strong in the face of rejection and danger. Pray their strength shines amid adversity.

Monday, 2 March

Your intercession is a lifeline. Pray for Beatriz*, a missionary in Central Mexico's highly persecuted area known as the "Circle of Silence". Ask God to protect her and her family.

Tuesday, 3 March

Beatriz disciples a group of women in Mexico who are discovering their true identity in God. She asks:

"Pray for the Circle of Silence, that one day we can call it the Circle of Hope."

Wednesday, 4 March

Concha* from Mexico met Jesus through Beatriz's women's group. She has faced family rejection and even lost her job. "Pray that God gives me strength," Concha says.

Thursday, 5 March

Concha from Mexico asks us to pray for her children, that they "never grow weary of following Christ. Pray for peace in this town."

Friday, 6 March

Intercede for mothers who are raising their children to love Jesus where faith is rejected. Pray for wisdom and patience.

Saturday, 7 March

Pray with women displaced from their homes. Ask God to fill them with peace when fear or doubt arises.

Sunday, 8 March

Today is International Women's Day. Pray with persecuted women of faith – that they would continue to be beacons of light in the most difficult places to follow Jesus.

Monday, 9 March

Today, pray for Christian women living in Afghanistan. If an Afghan woman's faith is discovered, her life and her family can be in grave danger.

Tuesday, 10 March

Pray for Afghan women who have fled their country for neighbouring nations. Pray they will find safe places to live and provision for their needs.

Wednesday, 11 March

Ariana* (pictured on cover), an Afghan Christian

woman who lives outside the country, asks: "Pray that Afghan women not only survive, but that they would be like Esther, with boldness and courage."

Thursday, 12 March

Pray with Ariana, asking God to "touch the heart of every person in Afghanistan, so that they may come to faith."

Friday, 13 March

Pray with Vannida*, a widow from Southeast Asia who continues to serve the Lord despite immense suffering. Pray that she would sense God's daily presence.

Saturday, 14 March

When Vannida's* husband refused to stop ministering to others, he was killed for it in Southeast Asia. Ask God for confidence as she faces authorities and relatives.

Sunday, 15 March

Lift up Open Doors ministry partners who work alongside persecuted women of faith. Ask God to protect them as they serve God's people.

Persecuted women are strengthened through Biblical training.



YEMEN

Monday, 16 March

Pray that believers in Yemen would be prepared to face persecution. At any moment, they could be arrested for leaving Islam.

Tuesday, 17 March

When our local partners met Yemeni believer Majed*, he was expecting to be arrested amid a government crackdown on the Church. Pray for strength.

Wednesday, 18 March

Several of Majed's* Christian friends have been arrested, and he was feverishly memorising Bible passages to be prepared for prison. Pray that God's Word would be a constant.

Thursday, 19 March

Ask God to comfort and encourage Christian prisoners and their families. Pray fear won't stop Yemeni believers from continuing their work.

CENTRAL ASIA

Friday, 20 March

Meet Nurlan* from Central Asia. He's one of the many recipients of Bibles provided through Open Doors. Pray for his perseverance.

Saturday, 21 March

Nurlan used to abuse drugs, but as he read Scripture, he found the strength to abstain. Pray that God would sustain him and his family.

Sunday, 22 March

Pray with Naira* from Central Asia. When she shared with her co-workers that she had become a Christian, one employee filed a police complaint. Praise God for Naira's boldness.

Monday, 23 March

Naira from Central Asia says that persecution has strengthened her faith. Please pray for her endurance as she continues to work with people hostile to her faith.

SUB-SAHARAN AFRICA

Tuesday, 24 March

Praise God! Nigerian Pastor Barnabas* has a new house – no longer living in a makeshift tent in an overcrowded IDP camp. Thank you for what you've done!

Wednesday, 25 March

Pray for strength and restoration for the Napala village in Mozambique. In a four-day extremist attack, 120 Christians were killed and two churches destroyed.

Thursday, 26 March

In 2025, 76 Mozambican Christians were killed by jihadists; 72 000 people fled their homes. Pray for the protection and witness of Mozambican believers.

Friday, 27 March

Pray with Pastor Daniel in the DRC: "Pray that our country will have lasting peace that comes from God."

Saturday, 28 March

Due to extremist attacks, Pastor Soré's family had fled from their village in Burkina Faso and were struggling to survive. He and his family have a new home and a new church building. Praise God!

Sunday, 29 March

Pastor Soré is preaching again to his small but

growing church, fulfilling his life's calling to share the Gospel. Pray that those he's teaching would grow to have mighty voices of faith.

Monday, 30 March

Pray with the church in Nigeria's Kwara State. After a brazen attack during a church service, Christians remain on edge. Pray for restoration.

Tuesday, 31 March

Pastor Maturin, a church leader in Burkina Faso, shared: "The Bible encourages us to pray for our enemies." Pray with him today.
